God has instituted some powerful dynamics in the world to help us lead a victorious life.

Today I will share with you one such dynamic. It's the power of your words.

As we look to the Lord as an example we see that when God spoke in Genesis creation manifested.

The Universe is created and upheld by the Word of God. God has placed within WORDS innate power that has the ability to either build up or tear down, encourage or discourage, communicate faith or install fear. Words have the power to belittle or inspire.

My prayer for you during this series is that the Lord gives you a revelation on this and that as you start to think differently and talk differently that your life will take a great leap forward for the good.

Let's lay a foundation first by looking at the Lord and how He always leads by example.

Hebrews 11:3 By faith we understand that the worlds were framed (HOW?) by the word of God, so that the things which are seen (the things in the world that we can see) were not (Hold it right here. The things that we see in the world were created by a supernatural force of creation) made of things which are visible.

Genesis 1:3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

6 Then God said, "Let there be a firmament in the midst of the waters, and let it divide the waters from the waters."

9 Then God said, "Let the waters under the heavens be gathered together into one place, and let the dry *land* appear"; and it was so.

11 Then God said, “Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb *that* yields seed, *and* the fruit tree *that* yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed *is* in itself, on the earth”; and it was so.

14 Then God said, “Let there be lights in the firmament of the heavens to divide the day from the night; and let them be for signs and seasons, and for days and years; **15** and let them be for lights in the firmament of the heavens to give light on the earth”; and it was so.

20 Then God said, “Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens.”

24 Then God said, “Let the earth bring forth the living creature according to its kind: cattle and creeping thing and beast of the earth, *each* according to its kind”; and it was so.

26 Then God said, “Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.

Whatever God said manifested. How powerful is God in that everything He said came to pass.

Isaiah 55:11 So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; it shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it.

Whatever your need is, as you speak God's Word over it, God will prosper it in the area for which it was sent.

If God be for me who can be against me.

1) YOUR WORDS CAN DEFILE YOU

Isaiah 6:1 In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His *robe* filled the temple. **2** Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. **3** And one cried to another and said:

“Holy, holy, holy *is* the Lord of hosts;The whole earth *is* full of His glory!”

4 And the posts of the door were shaken by the voice of him who cried out, and the house was filled with smoke.

5 So I said:

“Woe *is* me, for I am undone! Because I *am* a man of unclean lips, And I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips;For my eyes have seen the King,The Lord of hosts.”

6 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a live coal *which* he had taken with the tongs from the altar. **7** And he touched my mouth *with it*, and said:

“Behold, this has touched your lips;Your iniquity is taken away,And your sin purged.”

8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying:

“Whom shall I send,And who will go for Us?”

Then I said, “Here *am* I! Send me.”

Matthew 15:11 Not what goes into the mouth defiles a man; but what comes out of the mouth, this defiles a man.”

God wants to use you and bless you but there are things that can limit or block you. Here God is saying that He wants to send you out into the world for a divine ASSIGNMENT BUT one key factor is your mouth, your words.

I pray the Lord will help you not to say things that can defile your spirit. Cussing, swearing, rude jokes, racist remarks etc. These things are in our hearts and the overflow is what we say, so we need the Lord to cleanse us and set us free from this bondage.

2) WHAT YOU SAY ABOUT YOURSELF POSITIONS YOU FOR BLESSINGS OR GETS YOU IN TROUBLE

Psalm 141:3 Set a guard, O Lord, over my mouth; Keep watch over the door of my lips.

Proverbs 18:21 Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

You need to speak blessings over your life. You can control that.

There is so much negativity around us and people say so many things about us and to us.

People see us through their lens BUT

We need to see ourselves through HIS EYES and through the WORD.

I'm blessed and highly favored

I am seated with Christ in heavenly places...

I am the righteousness of God in Christ Jesus

I'm in RIGHT standing with God

I'm blessed

I am more than a conqueror

I can do all things through Christ

3) WHAT YOU SAY TO OTHERS BLESSES THEM OR GETS YOU IN TROUBLE?

Proverbs 18:4 The words of a man's mouth *are* deep waters; The wellspring of wisdom *is* a flowing brook.

6 A fool's lips enter into contention, And his mouth calls for blows. **7** A fool's mouth *is* his destruction, And his lips *are* the snare of his soul. **8** The words of a talebearer *are* like tasty trifles, And they go down into the inmost body.

James 3:8 But no man can tame the tongue. *It is* an unruly evil, full of deadly poison. **9** With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God. **10** Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so. **11** Does a spring send forth fresh *water* and bitter from the same opening?

Colossians 4:6 Let your speech always *be* with grace, seasoned with salt, that you may know how you ought to answer each one.

Ephesians 4:29 Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.

Psalms 34:13 Keep your tongue from evil, And your lips from speaking deceit.

HERE IS SOME ADVICE:

Watch your tone when speaking to people. I've been there. Someone has either lied to you or been disrespectful and you want to give them a pieve of your mind.

Or it can be a disagreement with your wife, kids, parents, friends or work colleagues. You're feeling frustrated and you just want to vent.

Proverbs 15:1 A soft answer turns away wrath, But a harsh word stirs up anger. **2** The tongue of the wise uses knowledge rightly, But the mouth of fools pours forth foolishness.

4) YOUR PROVISION IS IN YOUR WORDS

Joshua 1:8 This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success.

James 2:2 ...Yet you do not have because you do not ask. **3** You ask and do not receive, because you ask amiss, that you may spend *it* on your pleasures.

Job 22:28 You will also declare a thing, And it will be established for you; So light will shine on your ways.

2 Kings 4:1 A certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets cried out to Elisha, saying, "Your servant my husband is dead, and you know that your servant feared the Lord. And the creditor is coming to take my two sons to be his slaves."

2 So Elisha said to her, "What shall I do for you? Tell me, what do you have in the house?" And she said, "Your maidservant has nothing in the house but a jar of oil."

3 Then he said, "*Go, borrow vessels from everywhere, from all your neighbors—empty vessels; do not gather just a few. 4 And when you have come in, you shall shut the door behind you and your sons; then pour it into all those vessels, and set aside the full ones.*"

5 So she went from him and shut the door behind her and her sons, who brought *the vessels* to her; and she poured *it* out. **6** Now it came to pass,

when the vessels were full, that she said to her son, "Bring me another vessel."

And he said to her, "*There is* not another vessel." So the oil ceased. **7** Then she came and told the man of God. And he said, "Go, sell the oil and pay your debt; and you *and* your sons live on the rest."

Philippians 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

HE IS JEHOVAH JIREH MY PROVIDER

Genesis 22:14 And Abraham called the name of the place, The-Lord-Will-Provide; as it is said to this day, "In the Mount of the Lord it shall be provided."

HE LAYS A TABLE BEFORE ME IN THE PRESENCE OF MY ENEMIES AND I LIVE IN THE OVERFLOW

Psalms 23:5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over.

SURELY GOODNESS AND MERCY SHALL FOLLOW ME ALL THE DAYS OF MY LIFE

Psalms 23:6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me All the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the Lord Forever.

I'M BLESSED GOING IN AND BLESSED GOING OUT, BLESSED IN THE FIELDS, CITIES AND VALLEYS

Expect God's blessings to be all around you in life.

Deuteronomy 28:1 “Now it shall come to pass, if you *diligently obey* the voice of the Lord your God, to observe carefully all His commandments which I command you today, that the Lord your God will set you high above all nations of the earth. **2** And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God:

3 “Blessed *shall you be* in the city, and blessed *shall you be* in the country.

4 “Blessed *shall be* the fruit of your body, the produce of your ground and the increase of your herds, the increase of your cattle and the offspring of your flocks.

5 “Blessed *shall be* your basket and your kneading bowl.

6 “Blessed *shall you be* when you come in, and blessed *shall you be* when you go out.

7 “The Lord will cause your enemies who rise against you to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways.

8 “The Lord will command the blessing on you in your storehouses and in all to which you set your hand, and He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you.

9 “The Lord will establish you as a holy people to Himself, just as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the Lord your God and walk in His ways. **10** Then all peoples of the earth shall see that you are called by the name of the Lord, and they shall be afraid of you. **11** And the Lord will grant you plenty of goods, in the fruit of your body, in the increase of your livestock, and in the produce of your ground, in the land of which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you. **12** The Lord will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow. **13** And the Lord will make you the head and not the tail; you shall be above only, and not be beneath, if you heed the commandments of the Lord your God, which I command you today, and are careful to observe *them*. **14**

So you shall not turn aside from any of the words which I command you this day, *to* the right or the left, to go after other gods to serve them.
